



## Steven Ray Hannaford

Steven Ray Hannaford, son of the late Wayne and Matilda (Resler) Hannaford, was born September 15, 1947, in Alva, Oklahoma, and passed away March 9, 2019, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, at the age of 71 years, 5 months, and 22 days.

Steve graduated from Alva High School with the Class of '65, then obtained his Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration from NWOSU. He sold cars at Washburn Motor Company and Mark Ream Motors for many years. After two years of retirement, he then went to work at Wal-Mart.

Steve attended Sacred Heart Catholic Church.
