Interment will be in the Waynoka Municipal Cemetery. Tammy Wheeler, the youngest of twin daughters, was born November 18, 1970, at Woodward, Oklahoma. She passed away on October 1, 2017, in Tulsa, OK, after a brief bout of pneumonia at the age of 46 years, 10 months, and 13 days.

Tammy attended Mooreland School for her entire school life except for a brief 4 month period in Louisiana. She graduated with Honors in 1989, then finished up an assistant business degree at High Plains Technology in Woodward.
