Timothy Daniel Bodenschatz, son of the late Newton Amos and Lorina Magdalena Margaretha (Lohmann) Bodenschatz, was born November 26, 1947, at Alva, and passed away January 1, 2023, at Alva, at the age of 75 years, 1 month, and 5 days.

Tim was raised in Alva and graduated from Alva High School. Tim proudly served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War and was injured on June 7, 1968, in the Republic of Vietnam. He received a Purple Heart on July 3, 1968. He was honorably discharged in 1970. On August 24, 1968, he was united in marriage to Connie Sue Graves. To this marriage two daughters were born, Jennifer and Tanya. He later married Glenna Mae Hendricks on November 23, 1984. Tim was a dozer operator/truck driver for many years until his retirement. He was a member of the Alva Moose Lodge and enjoyed playing poker.

Besides his parents, Newton and Lorina, he was preceded in death by his

brother, David Bodenschatz.
