Travis Hugh Walker, son of the late Arthur Mardall and Lenora Beatrice (Wythe) Walker, was born June 12, 1934, at Oklahoma City and passed away peacefully surrounded by family July 21, 2021, at Liberal, Kansas, at the age of 87 years, one month, and 9 days.
