Travis Clay Whitaker, son of Jean Etta (Tackett) Whitaker and Roy Willis Whitaker, was born July 23, 1973, in Anthony, Kansas, and passed away June 3, 2020, at his home northwest of Alva, in Woods County, Oklahoma, at the age of 46 years, 10, months, and 11 days.
