



## Tyrel D. Coleman Dotson

Tyrel D. Coleman, son of Robert and Rose Dotson, was born March 17, 1980, at Tulsa and passed away August 11, 2024, at Alva, at the age of 44 years, 4 months, and 25 days.

Tyrel and his parents moved outside of Buffalo, Oklahoma, to a dairy farm in 1981. He was promoted to big brother the following year when his brother, Clint, was born. He loved playing golf and had a powerful swing that sent the golf ball a country mile. While golf was fun for Ty, being with his family and friends was the most important part of his life.

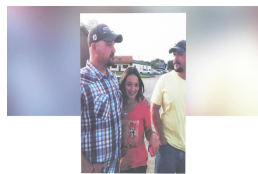
