



Vaughn Eugene Rader

April 30, 1964 - August 21, 2021

Memorial services for Vaughn Eugene Rader will be 2:00 p.m. Friday, August 27, 2021, at the Freedom Christian Church with Pastor Mark Kinkel officiating. Vaughn was cremated at his request under the direction of Marshall Funeral Home of Alva.

Vaughn Eugene Rader, son of the late Ernest Eugene Rader and Rita Jeanne (Vincent) Winn, was born April 30, 1964, in Alva, Oklahoma, and passed away August 21, 2021, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, at the age of 57 years, 3 months, and 21 days.

Vaughn graduated from Chisholm High School with the Class of 1982. In 1990, he was united in marriage to Kim Mitchell in Freedom. In 1989, he started with the Oklahoma Department of Corrections and retired from Bill Johnson Correctional Center in 2010. He was a CERT Commander and CLEET certified firearms instructor and sniper instructor. He started ranching in 1993 until his death. He was dedicated to maintaining and improving his family ranch.

He was a competitive archer and bow hunter. In 2015, he killed a bull elk in New Mexico that placed ninth in the Pope and Young record books. He enjoyed any type of outdoor hunting and fishing activity.

Vaughn is survived by his wife, Kim, of Alva; two sons, Mitchell Rader and wife, Hayden, of Alva, and Logan Rader of Enid; his mother, Jeanne Winn and husband, Dudley, of Kingston, Oklahoma; two brothers, Darrin Rader and wife, Michelle, of Orlando, Oklahoma, and Dale Rader of Columbia Falls, Montana; five step siblings; other relatives and many friends.

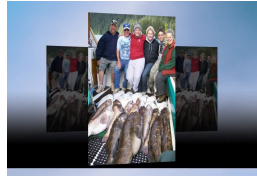
