Vera Mae Morris, daughter of the late James Harold and Lottie Mae (Gordon) Cattin, was born April 14, 1926, and passed away August 16, 2011, at Waynoka, Oklahoma, at the age of 85 years, 4 months, and two days.

Vera attended school in Canadian, Texas, and Waynoka. On November 29, 1944, she was united in marriage to Aaron Morris at Columbia, South Carolina.
