Funeral services for Verna M. Maltby Price will be 1:00 p.m. Wednesday, August 1, 2007, at the Wentworth Chapel with Rev. James Endecott officiating. Gumm, daughter of the late Archibald Bidwell and Margarete Ann (Schweisenberger) Gumm, was born December 4, 1915, at Covington, Oklahoma, and passed away July 28, 2007, at El Reno, Oklahoma, at the age of 91 years, 7 months, and 24 days.

Verna grew up in the Covington and Mulhall area and graduated from Marland High School with the Class of 1933. On August 4, 1934, she was united in marriage to Lawrence William Maltby at Cherokee, Oklahoma. They lived and farmed in the Blackwell area until his death in 1947. She married Paul Price in 1949 in Perry, Oklahoma. They made their home in the Kaw City area until 1963. She worked as a beautician and waitress before settling in Carmen where she worked at the Dairy Boy and Mini-Mart and she did local babysitting.

She was a member of the Jehovah's Witness. She was active in the local library and frequently read at story time. She enjoyed crocheting, crossword puzzles, pictures puzzles, and playing all types of games, particularly Rook and Scrabble.
