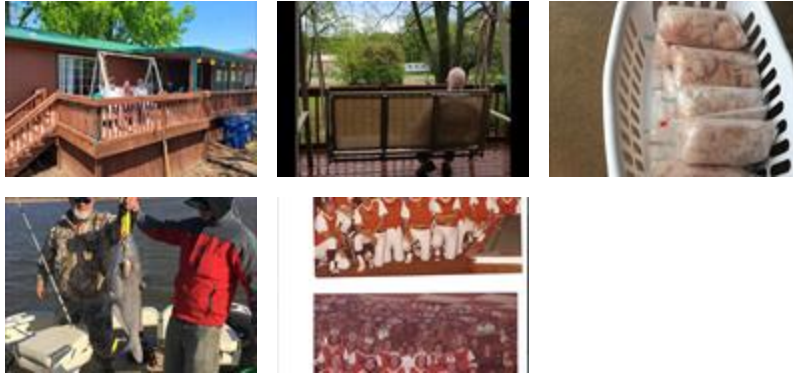

I will miss you Wild Bill. But I will see you again.

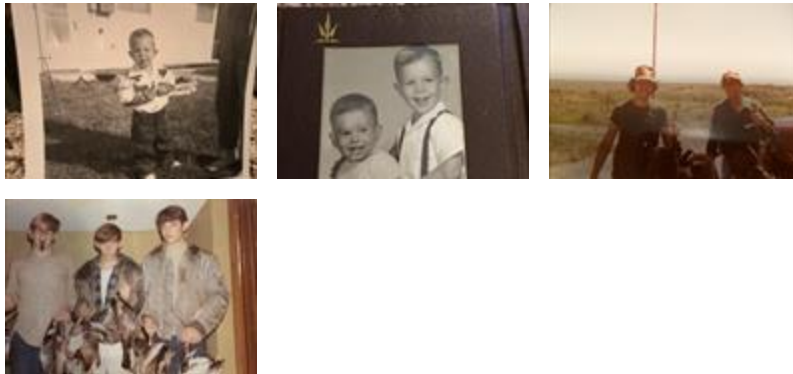
