Graveside services for Williams F. Crowley were held Thursday, May 5, 2016, at Alva Municipal Cemetery under the direction of Marshall Funeral Home of Alva.

William Franklin Crowley, son of the late Elijah Roland and Inez Leona (Lively) Crowley, was born December 27, 1927, at Patesville, Kentucky, and passed away May 3, 2016, at Alva, Oklahoma, at the age of 88 years, 4 months, and 6 days.

While serving in the United States Air Force, he was united in marriage to Betty Rebel on March 27, 1954, at March Air Force Base in California.
