Wilma Jean Johnson, daughter of James Eugene and Grace Mae (Uhl) Murrow, was born on February 25, 1933, west of Alva, Oklahoma in Woods County. She passed away on February 13, 2023 at the age of 89 years, 11 months, and 19 days.

She attended Farry High School graduating in 1951. In 1969, Wilma went to Seward County Community College. She received her Bachelors degree in 1972 from Panhandle State University and her Masters in 1982 from Northwestern Oklahoma State University. Wilma was an elementary school teacher for 22 years retiring in 1972.

She married Jackie Junior Johnson on August 4, 1952 at Cora Nazarene Church in Woods County, Oklahoma.
