Yvonne Alcestus Ferguson, daughter of the late Robert Arealish and Myrtle Elizabeth (Hullet) Cropp, was born May 26, 1924, on the farm near Avard in Woods County, Oklahoma, and passed away June 26, 2007, at the Waynoka Nursing Center at the age of 83 years and 1 month.

Yvonne graduated from Avard High School with the class of 1943, then obtained her teacher's certification. She taught at Highland School for one year. On July 17, 1944, she was united in marriage to Everett Casey Ferguson at Woodward. She was a farm wife who later worked as a cook at E. P. Clapper Memorial Hospital and the Waynoka Nursing Center.
